For those archers shooting with the Longbow or the Compound bow brooches will be awarded in Gilt, Silver and Bronze according to position.

The Society's Bronze Brooches will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd highest scores both Ladies and Gentlemen in the Classification Groups Bowman, I, II, III (and below). Winners of Silver Brooches are not eligible for Bronze Brooches.

* *These awards will be made on an unrewarded basis in the preferential order - score, hits, golds.

In addition there will be Visitors Awards and Handicap Meeting Prizes.

The British Longbow Society's Medals will be awarded in the National Rounds shot at the Longbow Meeting.

Notes

The Meeting is open to all members of the G.N.A.S. excepting those under the age of 16 years and those under the age of 18 years unless they have reached senior Third Class archer standard.

Entries from members of S.C.A.S. can only be accepted if their Club has affiliated for the current year.

Members of the B.L.B.S. are eligible to shoot on Long Bow Day.

Record status shoots will be liable to Drug Testing and Competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Under GNAS Rules all competitors are required to wear plain Dark green and/or White. Registered Club Colours are also acceptable.

COUNTY TEAMS

County Teams - recurve - consist of four or fewer archers.

County Teams - compound - consist of three archers or fewer, one of whom, must be a lady.

The qualifications for inclusion in a County team are currently laid down in the Society's "Constitution and Rules".

CLUB TEAMS.

A Club Team consists of two ladies and two gentlemen (or fewer). An archer may shoot for one Club only. If more than one Club is shown on the Entry Form the archers score will be counted for that Club which is shown first.

MARRIED COUPLES

Married couples may shoot for the Cecil Rhodes Cup. Any type of bow, eligible for this Meeting may be used.

GOLD SWEEP

LONG BOWS

Dividends are paid on every arrow whose shaft is totally within two and two fifths inches of the pinhole in the morning only on longbow day, and, for 100 yards (gentlemen) and 80 yards (ladies), any arrow totally within the gold area.

RECURVE/COMPOUND BOWS.

Dividends are paid on every arrow whose shaft is totally within three-quarters of one inch of the pinhole on the 80 yards (Ladies) and 100 yards (Gentlemen) distances on both days York/Hereford rounds.

CHALLENGE TROPHIES

Will holders of the Societies Challenge Trophies please return them to the Tournament Secretary on the ground on the **Thursday** before shooting commences.

They cannot be accepted at any other time or place.

TARGET MOVING

It is requested that Gentlemen Archers assist in the moving of targets between distances.

HOTELS

Intending Competitors are advised to reserve hotel accommodation as early as possible. A list of hotels may be obtained from the Tourist Office, Winchester City.

CAR PARKING

This will be on the ground subject to careful parking and strict compliance with instructions.

DOGS

Owners of dogs are reminded that we shoot on a sports ground. Dogs are only allowed on the condition that they are under control **AT ALL TIMES**.

CATERING

Morning and Afternoon coffee/teas will be provided free to competitors.

A hot/cold lunch will be available, for all four days of the meeting in the pavilion on the ground. Filled rolls and sandwiches will also be available.

It will greatly assist catering arrangements if competitors intending to take lunch will apply, and pay for, the lunches when completing their Entry Forms.
